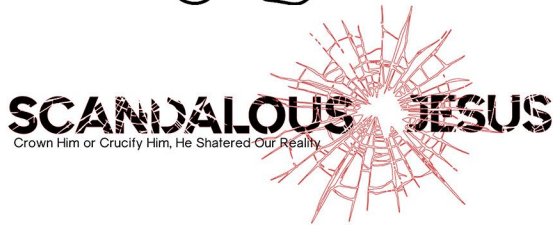

Because we prioritize spiritual formation, we prioritize mentoring, serving, small groups and worship service above other activities. We call these the Core 4.
